## True colours of LGTF revealing themselves

The true colours of shadowy anti-fish farming group Lets Grow Tasmania's Future are beginning to show through with an admission from Environment Tasmania that they are involved.

Environment Tasmania has admitted to the ABC that they are aligned with the organisation, despite none of their details being on the LGTF website and no links or admission of alignment on their own website.

Millionaire Graeme Wood must now address suggestions he is the group's secretive backer after a search of the group's domain name reveals it is registered to a graemewood.org email address\*.

Mr Wood's potential involvement makes a mockery of the organisation's claims to be a "non-politically-aligned group of Tasmanians" as Mr Wood has previously donated over \$2.1 million to the Greens, including the largest political donation in Australian history and a \$130,000 donation to the Tasmanian Greens during last year's federal election.

Mr Wood also has form in working with the Greens in trying to destroy Tasmanian jobs. He purchased the Triabunna woodchip mill in order to shut it and try and close the forest industry, and he is on the record as saying he would be the 'neighbour from hell'^ to any salmon expansion plans on the east coast.

If Mr Wood is behind this group it confirms that the LGTF is nothing but an anti-job green front-group which can't be believed.
